For best results, use throughout the growing season to prevent buildup of insect populations from a distance of 3 to 4 feet using short bursts (one second). NOTE: Holding close to foliage may result in overwatering and damage to foliage.

Apply in the early morning or late evening when the air is still, treating all foliage with particular attention to the underside of leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat applications necessary after heavy rains. Do not apply to food crops within one day of harvest.
