(For hard to control pests such as whiteflies, Cuban laurel and flowerthrips, Mealybugs, two-spotted and southern red mites, rose midge, and scales (crawlers): It may be necessary to spray 2 to 3 times, waiting 7 to 10 days between each application.) Additional sprays may be needed if plants become reinfested.

WHEN TO APPLY: Spray before disease appears or at first sign of insects or mites. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals when insect populations occur. Do not apply to wilted plants. (For Diseases: Apply every 7 to 10 days if disease conditions persist./For Insect and Disease Control – Spray weekly, starting before disease appears or at first signs of pests.
