

Vegetables	Pests	Amount to Use When to Apply
Sweet Com & Sweet Potatoes	Billbugs, Cutworms, Grubs, Flea Beetle (larvae), Sweet Potato Beetles & Wireworms	Apply 1½ cups (½ lb) per 100 sq. ft. just prior to planting and work into the top 4 to 6 inches of soil.
Onions (bulb) & Radishes -	Onion Maggots & Root Maggots	Apply 1 cup (1/3 lb) per 100 linear feet (onion bulbs) or 110 linear feet (radish seed) in the furrow at the time of planting.
Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Chinese Cabbage, Collards, Kale, Kohlrabi, Rutabagas & Turnips	Root Maggots	Apply 1½ cups (½ lb) per 100 linear feet in the furrow with the seeds or transplants at the time of planting.
(Note, do not use Rutabaga tops for food or feed.)
