For use only in commercial seed treatment equipment. Not for use in hopper box, planter box, slurry box, or other on-farm seed treatment applications. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Storage at low temperatures is not recommended. Do not store above 95°F. Do not store in direct sunlight.

Canola, rapeseed and mustard seed: Apply 21.5 fl oz of PROSPER T400 to 100 lbs of seed using commercial seed treatment equipment.

Seed Bag Tag

The Federal Seed Act requires that the container of seed treated with Prosper T400 must be labeled with the following statements:

- This seed has been treated with 21.75% clothianidin, 0.544% trifloxystrobin, 3.81% carboxin, and 0.408% metalaxyl.
- Do not use treated seed for food, feed, oil production or ethanol production.
- Use planting equipment that will plant treated seed into the soil at a minimum depth of 0.5 inches.

In addition, the US Environmental Protection Agency requires the following statements on the container of seed treated with Prosper T400.

- Store away from feeds and foodstuffs.
- Wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical resistant gloves when handling treated seeds.
- This bag contains seed treated with carboxin. This product may have effects on federally listed threatened or endangered species or their critical habitat in some counties. It is a violation of federal law to kill, harm or harass listed animal species with out authorization. To limit the potential for such impacts when using this product, consult and follow the instructions provided in the EPA Endangered Species Bulletin for the County or Parish in which you are applying the seed. To determine whether your County or Parish has a Bulletin consult http://www.epa.gov/espp before each season's use of this product.
- Dispose of all excess treated seed. Left over treated seed may be double sown around the headland or buried away
 from water sources in accordance with local requirements. Do not contaminate water bodies when disposing of
 planting equipment washwaters.
- Dispose of seed packaging in accordance with local requirements.
- This compound may be highly toxic to bees exposed directly (contact). Ensure that planting equipment is functioning
 properly in accordance with manufacturing recommendations to minimize seed coat abrasion during planting to
 reduce dust which can drift to blooming crops or weeds.

 the soil/media subsurface.
- Rapeseed greens and seed grown or harvested from PROSPER T400-treated seed must not be used for feed or human consumption. Rapeseed grown and harvested from PROSPER T400-treated seed is only for industrial uses and cannot be used for edible oil or any other human/feed consumption.
- Areas planted with treated seed may be replanted immediately with canola, cotton, corn (field, pop and sweet),
 Cereal Grains except rice, Fruiting Vegetables (including Cucurbits), Leafy Vegetables (including Brassica
 Vegetables), mustard, rapeseed, Sorghum, Soybean, Sugar Beet, Tuberous and Corm Vegetables. These areas
 may also be replanted after 30 days with grasses, non-grass animal feeds, and dried beans. Do not plant any other
 crop in the treated area for at least four months after treated seeds are planted.

PROSPER T400 is a systemic insecticide and fungicide seed treatment for use on canola, mustard seed, and rapeseed for control of certain insect pests and for control of seed rot, damping off, seedling blight and early season root rot caused by *Pythium, Rhizoctonia, Fusarium* and *Alternaria*. Also controls seedborne Blackleg. The insecticide component, clothianidin, controls flea beetles on seeds and seedlings of canola (including Brassica napus and Brassica rapa), mustard seed, and rapeseed. For protection of seeds and emerging seedlings only.

For use in commercially available equipment designed for seed treatment only. Not for use in hopper-box, slurry-box, or similar seed treatment applications used at planting. This product is to be used in liquid or slurry treaters. Mix thoroughly before use or use entire container at one time. Pre-test all tank mixes to determine physical compatibility between formulations. Follow all cautions and limitations on labeling of all products used in mixtures.

All seed treated with this product must be conspicuously colored at the time of treatment. If this product contains no colorant, an appropriate colorant must be added to distinguish seed and to prevent subsequent inadvertent use as a food for man or a feed for animals. Regulations pertaining to coloration of treated seed enforced by 40 CFR 153.155 must be strictly adhered to when using this product.


