DIRECTIONS

FOR HOUSEHOLD CLEANING: Use 4 tablespoonfuls of OLD 97 Pine Oil Disinfectant to 1 gallon soapy water for scrubbing sinks, lavatories, bath tubs, floors and walls. Leave solution on surfaces being treated for 15 minutes or more before rinsing.

FOR DRAINS: Use one tablespoonful of undiluted OLD 97 Pine Oil Disinfectant poured directly into drain. Let stand 15 minutes before using drain. For deodorization and cleaning only. Not intended for disinfection.

FOR GARBAGE CANS: Use ¼ cup OLD 97 Pine Oil Disinfectant to 1 quart soapy water. Scrub can and let stand 15 minutes before rinsing.
