FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Spray upwards into four corners of closed room, about 4 to 6 seconds for each 1000 cu. ft. About 6 to 8 seconds for average room Close windows and doors for about 15 minutes after treatment.

FLYING MOTHS, WASPS, HORNETS: Spray 20 to 25 seconds per 1000 cu. It Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, directly on insects when possible. Repeat as necessary.

ROACHES, ANTS, FLEAS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS: Spray liberally into cracks of woodwork, walls, floors, hiding and breeding places, directly on insects when possible. Thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of animal pets. Repeat as necessary

BEDBUGS: Spray bed frame, springs, mattress tufts, seams and all cracks and hiding places about bedroom.

MOTH WORMS, CARPET BEETLES: Clean, air and brush clothing, rugs, carpets and fabrics. Spray thoroughly from 3 ft. distances especially seams, folds, under collars and lapels. Clean and spray closets, drawers. Repeat approximately every 30 days.

CAUTION: Harmful if Swallowed! Repeated or prolonged contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use near heat or open flame Do not puncture container or dispose of in fire. Store in cool temperature, not in excess of 120° Fahrenheit.
