Directions For Use

Except as otherwise noted, applications should be made when insects first appear and be repeated as required. **Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.**

Asparagus Asparagus Beetle - Use 30 pounds per acre.

Beans Mexican Bean Beetle - Use 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Thorough coverage of under surfaces of leaves is essential for effective control.

Beets Flea Beetle - Use 20 to 30 pounds per acre.

Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower Imported Cabbageworm, Cabbage Looper, Flea Beetle - Use 25 pounds per acre.

Cucumbers, Melons, Squash Cucumber Beetles, Squash Bug Nymphs, Aphids - Use 25 pounds per acre. Squash Vine Borer - Use 30 pounds per acre. Apply thoroughly around base of plants at weekly intervals.

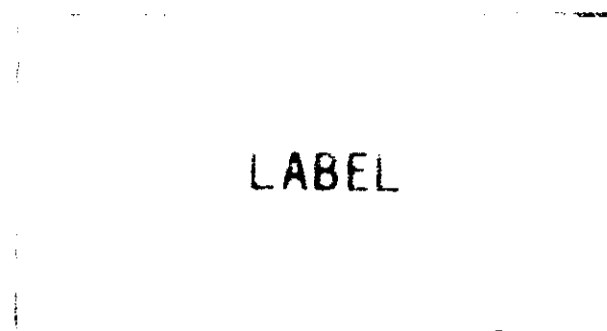
Eggplant Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle - Use 30 to 40 pounds per acre.

Peas Pea Aphid, Pea Weevil - Use 30 pounds per acre. Three applications at 7-day intervals are usually necessary for Aphids. For Weevil, make first application when peas are 50% in bloom and repeat 5 to 7 days later. On late varieties 3 applications at 5-day intervals may be necessary.

Peppers Aphid, Flea Beetle, Pepper Maggot - Use 20 to 25 pounds per acre. For Maggot make first application when flies appear and repeat 5 days later.

Tomatoes Flea Beetle, Colorado Potato Beetle, Aphids - Use 30 to 40 pounds per acre.
