DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For Early and Late Blight of Potatoes use 4 lbs. in 100 gallons of water. Start applications when the plants are 6 inches high and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not apply more than 150 gallons of finished spray per acre.

For Early and Late Blight and Anthracnose of Tomatoes, use 4 lbs. in 100 gallons of water. Apply twice in seed beds and at intervals of 10 days to two weeks until Tomatoes are picked. Do not apply more than 150 gallons of finished spray per acre.

For Early and Late Blight of Celery use 4 lbs. in 100 gallons of water and make weekly applications. Do not apply more than 125 gallons of finished spray per acre.

For Downy Mildew of Cucumbers use 2 lbs. plus 2 lbs. of Hydrated Spray Lime in 100 gallons of water and apply at weekly intervals. Do not apply more than 125 gallons of finished spray per acre.

For Black Rot and Downy Mildew of Grapes use 2 lbs. plus 2 lbs. of Hydrated Spray Lime in 100 gallons of water.

Apply when first leaves appear, before blossoms open, after petal fall and after at 2 week intervals until within two weeks of harvest. Do not apply more than 75 gallons of finished spray per acre.

If a sticker is desired in the above sprays, use 1/2 lb. powdered Zinc Sulphate plus 1/2 lb. Hydrated Spray Lime per 100 gallons of water.

This material is compatible with organic insecticides, such as Pyrethrum, Derris, Cube, Nicotine Alkaloid (Black Leaf 155) DDT, and Arsenicals.
