

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim

if swallowed and victim is awake (conscious) make him vomit quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving soapy or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have victim tie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes white removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Antidote — administer atropine sulfate in large doses. TWO to FOUR mg intravenously or intramuscularly as 800n as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. 2-PAM chloride is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS, Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression At first sign of pulmonary edems, the patient should be given supplemental oxyger, and treated symptomatically.
