### ENVIRONMENTAL AND DISPOSAL CAUTIONS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds and streams. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DISPOSE OF WASTES by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Container should be disposed of by burying with wastes or by burning. Keep out of smoke.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**APPLE SCAB:** Apply as a protective fungicide in the pre-bloom, bloom and early cover stages using 40 pounds per acre on mature or nearly mature size trees. Make repeated applications as required to keep the foliage fully protected from the time new growth starts in the spring.

**CEDAR APPLE RUST:** Apply in pre-bloom, bloom, calyx and first cover stages as is usually determined for apple scab. Apply 40 pounds per acre on mature or nearly mature size trees.

**OTHER APPLE DISEASES:** For the control of Black Rot on fruit and foliage, Fly Speck, Sooty Blotch, Bitter Rot, Brooks Spot, Apple Blotch, Botryosphaeria Spot and Black Pox make applications as indicated for scab control since these are effective in controlling the diseases listed. When weather conditions favor the disease, shorten the application interval and make applications in advance of infection periods.

**PEACH BROWN ROT:** For blossom blight apply at 3 to 4 day intervals during bloom, timing the applications to keep newly opening blossoms covered. For fruit rot apply at petal fall and two weeks later. Make one or more additional applications beginning one month before harvest repeating at 7 day intervals. Begin earlier if any rot is seen on green fruit. Apply 40 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

**PEACH RHIZOPUS ROT:** Apply as directed for fruit phase of brown rot.

**STRAWBERRIES:** For Gray Mold (Botrytis) apply 40 pounds per acre at 10 day intervals beginning at early blossom stage and continuing as necessary. Good coverage of buds, blossoms and developing fruit is required for best results. If applied within 3 days of harvesting remove residue by washing.

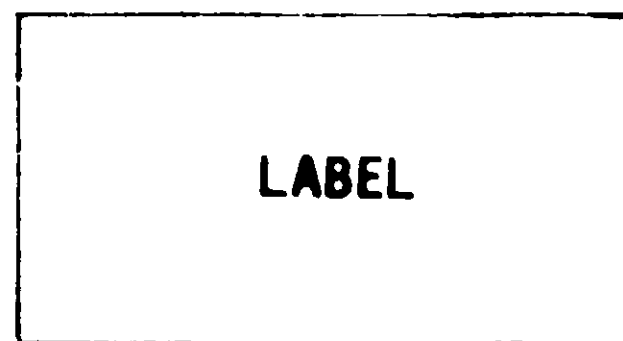
