DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Niagara Malachlor Livestock Spray is for use as
a spray or as a backrubber treatment on beef on-
ly.

HORN FLIES: FOR USE IN BACKRUBBERS FOR
BEEF CATTLE ONLY: Dilute at a 1-9 ratio using
1 gallon of Malachlor Livestock Spray and 9 gal-
lons fuel oil. These devices should be made con-
tinuously accessible, one for each 35 to 45 head
of cattle. Re-treat backrubbers every 2 to 3
weeks. This treatment will aid in the control of
lice.

HORN FLIES, LICE: FOR USE AS A LIVESTOCK
SPRAY ON BEEF CATTLE: Dilute at a 1-49 ratio
using 1 gallon Malachlor Livestock Spray and 49
gallons of water.

Apply as a complete coverage spray when insects
first appear. Repeat applications as needed us-
ually at 18 to 30 day intervals.

CAUTION: DO NOT TREAT CALVES UNDER
ONE MONTH OF AGE.
