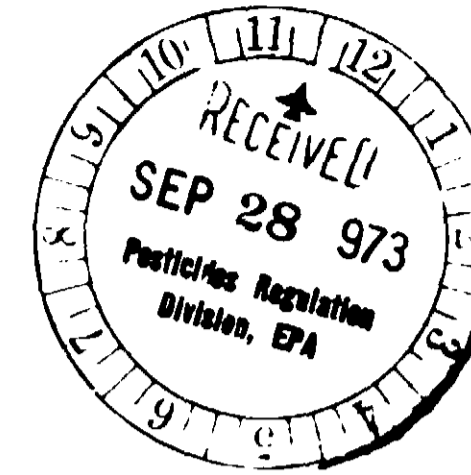

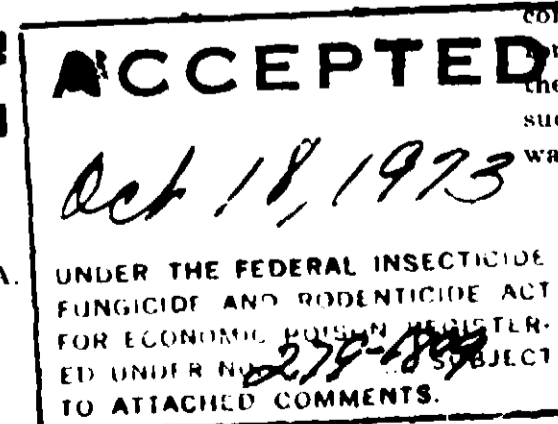

PRECAUTIONS

1. Time your sprays and use correct concentrations according to varieties and degree of ripeness desired.
2. Fruit should be harvested at proper maturity, but do not allow fruit to become over-ripe on trees before picking.
3. Do not use this material at a higher concentration than is recommended.
4. Do not use more than one application on a given variety.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The effectiveness of this spray is dependent on the condition of the foliage and thorough coverage. Foliage free from injury and disease is important for good results. Used correctly, this chemical will control the harvest drop of apples.

It should be clearly understood that when this material is used the fruit should be harvested at proper maturity and not left on trees to become highly colored and over-ripe since this spray prevents the earliest maturing fruits from dropping, these will be riper when the majority of fruits reach the best stage of maturity for picking. This is especially true on a variety such as McIntosh.

TIMING OF SPRAY

McINTOSH. For Immediate Market: Use ¼ pint in 100 gallons (20 ppm.) 7 to 8 days before harvest drop begins. Pick fruit at proper maturity. **Fruit to be stored:** Apply spray 4 to 5 days before harvest drop begins using ¼ pint in 100 gallons of water (10 ppm.). This should control drop for 2 weeks.

SUMMER VARIETIES. For varieties such as Early McIntosh and Wealthy, apply spray 2 weeks before harvest. Use ¼ pint per 100 gallons of water (20 ppm.). For Williams Early Red, use ¼ pint in 100 gallons of water (10 ppm.). Apply 2 weeks before harvest.

FALL VARIETIES. On Baldwin, Rome, Jonathan, Delicious, Spy, York and Staymen, application should be made 1 to 2 weeks before harvest. Use ¼ pint per 100 gallons of water (20 ppm.).

USED IN SPEED SPRAYERS

This material has been used successfully in speed sprayers both in a concentrate or dilute form. For effective spraying of this chemical with a speed sprayer, contact your State Agricultural Extension Service.

Do not re-use container.

Destroy by burying in a safe place.
