# Endrin 1.6 Methyl Parathion 1.6 Emulsifiable INSECTICIDE

NOT FOR USE OR STORAGE IN OR AROUND THE HOME  
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**PREPARATION OF SPRAY:** To prepare the spray mixture, measure out the required amount of this material and add it to the required amount of this material and add it to the proper amount of water. Mix thoroughly and apply, agitating continuously. Do not use in undiluted form.

**COTTON: Fleahoppers, Thrips - EARLY SEASON USE:** Use 1/2 to 1 pint in sufficient water to treat one acre. Apply when insects first appear and repeat as necessary.

**MID-SEASON AND LATE SEASON USE:** Aphids, Bollworm, Boll Weevil, Cotton Leaf Perforator, Cotton Leafworms, Fleahoppers, Grasshoppers, Rapid Plant Bug, Tarnished Plant Bug, Thrips, Desert and Two Spotted Mite - Use 1 to 2 pints per acre in sufficient water to provide uniform coverage. Begin applications when infestations reach the point where control is desired. Repeat at 3 to 5 day intervals depending upon the severity of the infestation and local conditions. Thorough Coverage is Necessary. Do not apply within 5 days of hand picking. Workers entering treated fields within 5 day of application should wear protective clothing. Do not graze dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter on treated fields; do not feed treated cotton trash to these animals.
