Directions for Use

Beans Bean Leaf Beetle, Cucumber Beetle, Japanese Beetle, Leafhoppers, Velvet Bean Caterpillar, Anthracnose, Rust - Use 30 pounds dust per acre. Armyworms, Corn Earworm, Stink Bugs, Tarnished Plant Bug - Use 40 pounds per acre. Begin treatment at first sign of disease. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not apply within 7 days of picking.

Cucumbers, Melons, Pumpkins, Squash Cucumber Beetles, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Pickleworm, Melonworm, Squash Bug, Anthracnose, Downy Mildew, Gummy Stem Blight, Alternaria Stem Blight - Use 25 pounds dust per acre. Begin treatment at first sign of disease. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.

Peppers, Tomatoes Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Anthracnose, Early and Late Blights, Gray Leaf Spot, Septoria Leaf Spot - Use 25 to 30 pounds dust per acre. For control of early and late blights, gray leaf spot and septoria leaf spot on tomatoes begin treatment when first fruit clusters are well formed or when disease threatens.

European Corn Borer, Flea beetles, Hornworms, Stink Bugs Use 50 pounds dust per acre. Begin treatment at first sign of disease. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 day intervals. Do not apply on tomatoes within 5 days of harvest.

Environmental and disposal cautions

Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not spray when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not contaminate water by spraying equipment, containers or wastes. Apply the product only in accordance with label directions.

Some phytopathogenic organisms may be sensitive to the presence of calcium naphthalene. If damage occurs, repeat application following up treatment.
