CROP: Tomatoes

TO CONTROL: Anthracnose, Early and Late Blights, Septoria Leaf Blight, Stemphylium Gray Leaf Spot, European Corn Borer, Flea Beetles, Fall Armyworm, Leafhoppers, Stink Bugs, Tomato Fruitworm, Hornworm and Colorado Potato Beetle.

Use 20 to 30 pounds of dust per acre. Apply when insects or disease first threaten and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals, or more often, as required to maintain control. If applied to greenhouse tomatoes, do not use on tender young plants.

Do not apply to tomatoes within 5 days of harvest.
