The first application should be made at the first appearance of the insect or disease to be controlled. 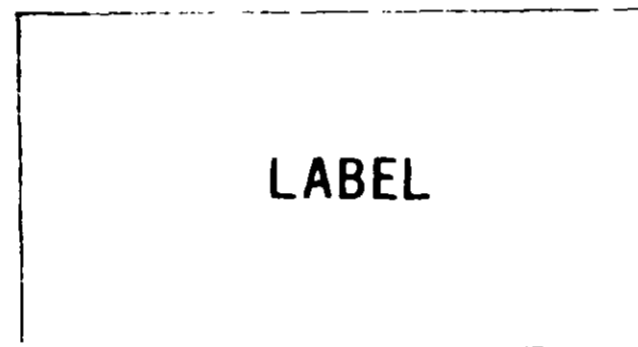
