diseases. Continue the applications throughout the season. Approaches to golf greens should be given treatment as well as the green itself. In conjunction with this treatment it is important to utilize good turf management practices.

FOR PREVENTATIVE TREATMENT: Apply 3 ounces or $\frac{2}{3}$ cupful per 1000 sq. feet or 1 lb. per 5000 sq. feet. Use only enough water to spray the turf thoroughly. This is usually 5 to 10 gallons of water per 1000 sq. feet. During periods of warm humid weather disease development usually increases and the time interval between treatments should be shortened.

IF DISEASE IS ESTABLISHED: Increase the rate to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ounces or 1 cupful per 1000 square feet or 1 pounds per 5000 square feet.

FOR SNOW MOLD CONTROL: Use 8 ounces per 1000 sq. feet in the late fall, just prior to freezing or snowfall. A second application in the spring of 3 ounces per 1000 sq. feet is necessary. Apply as soon as the snow melts.

CAUTION

Do not use grass or grass clippings from treated area for livestock feed. Do not permit animals to graze on the treated areas. Avoid contamination of fish pools or ponds.

Use of a dry filter dust mask over nose and mouth while preparing spray is recommended.
