CORN SOIL INSECT CONTROL: Corn Rootworm, Seed Corn Beetle - Apply 4 pounds per acre in the row at planting time or apply 8 pounds per acre as a broadcast treatment to soil surface before planting. Disc into top 3 or 4 inches of soil. White Grubs, White-fringed Beetle, Wireworms - Apply 10 to 20 pounds per acre as a broadcast treatment to soil surface before planting. Disc into top 3 or 4 inches of soil.

POTATOES: Japanese Beetle Larvae, White-tringed Beetle Larvae White Grubs Wireworms - Apply 16 to 20 pounds per acre. Make broadcast application prior to or at time of planting and work into the top 3 or 4 inches of soil. Increase dosage to 35 to 40 pounds per acre on peat or muck soils.
