# SULPHUR 10 THIODAN® 3 DUST

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when insects or disease first appear and repeat as necessary. May be applied with ground or airplane application equipment.

**GRAPES** to control Grape Leafhopper, Grape Leafhopper (Calif. Only) use 35 pounds per acre. For Leafhopper control repeat applications maybe necessary. Do not use on Concord Variety of grapes as severe injury is likely to occur. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Apply with ground application equipment only.

**BROCCOLI, CABBAGE** to control Cabbage Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Diamond back Moth Larvae, Flea Beetle, Harlequin Bugs, Stink Bugs, Imported Cabbage Worm use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

**CAULIFLOWER** to control Cabbage Looper, Flea Beetle, Harlequin Bug, Stink Bug, Imported Cabbage worm, Diamond-back Moth Larvae use 25 pounds per acre. Do not apply after edible parts begin to form. Close trim outer leaves prior to marketing.

**COTTON** to control Cotton Stink Bug, Lygus Bugs, Bollworm, Cabbage Looper, Cotton Leaf perforator use 35 pounds per acre. Do not apply after bolls begin to open. Do not graze meat or dairy animals in treated fields.

**HEAD LETTUCE** to control Cabbage Looper, Diamond-back Moth Larvae, Green Peach Aphid, Imported Cabbage Worm use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply more than 3 applications after thinning. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Remove outer leaves at harvest. Do not feed crop refuse to livestock.

**PEPPERS** to control Flea Beetle, Green Peach Aphid, Pepper Maggot and Hornworm use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

**POTATOES** to control Aphid, Leafhopper, Flea Beetle, Colorado Potato Beetle, Potato Tuberworm, Green Stinkbug, Southern Armyworm, Potato Psyllid, False Chinch Bug use 30-35 pounds per acre. No time limitation.

**STRAWBERRIES** to control Powdery Mildew, Meadow Spittlebug and Strawberry Aphid use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 4 days of picking. For multiple applications during the fruiting period, do not apply at intervals of less than 15 days or more than twice during any 35 day period.

**TOMATOES** to control Aphid, Flea Beetle, Hornworm, Colorado Potato Beetle, Tomato Psyllid, Whitefly, Stinkbug, Tomato Fruitworm, Cabbage Looper, Yellow Striped Armyworm and Tomato Russet Mite use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

**DRIED BEANS** to control Black Bean Aphid, Bean Leaf Skeletonizer and Mexican Bean Beetle use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 40 days of harvest. Do not feed treated threshings to livestock. Sulphur may injure certain varieties of beans, check sulphur tolerance prior to use.

**SUCCULENT BEANS** to control Cucumber Beetle use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply after pods begin to form. Do not feed treated threshings to livestock. Sulphur may injure certain varieties of beans, check sulphur tolerance prior to use.

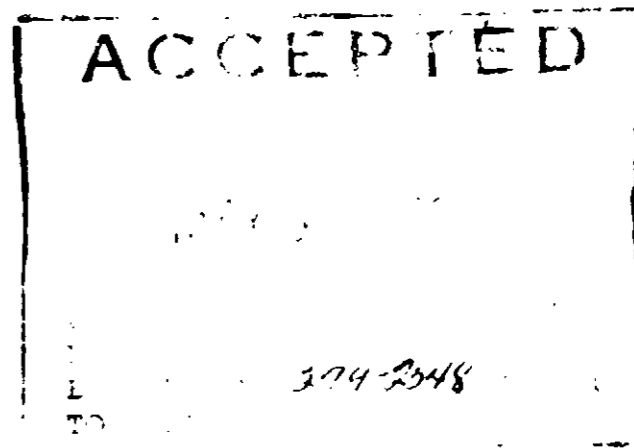

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Severe first appear and repeat as necessary. Ground or airplane application equipment.

Leafhopper, Grape Leafhopper (Calif. Only) re. For Leafhopper control repeat application. Do not use on Concord Variety of grapes as it occurs. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Application equipment only.

Control Cabbage Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Diamond-back Moth, Harlequin Bugs, Stink Bugs, Imported Flea Beetle. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

Cabbage Looper, Flea Beetle, Harlequin Bug, Cabbage Worm, Diamond-back Moth Larvae use 25 pounds per acre. Apply after edible parts begin to form. Prior to marketing.

Stink Bug, Lygus Bugs, Bollworm, Cabbage Rootworm use 35 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not graze meat or dairy animals in treated areas.

Cabbage Looper, Diamond-back Moth Larvae, Cabbage Worm use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not remove outer leaves at harvest. Do not feed treated plants to livestock.

Flea Beetle, Green Peach Aphid, Pepper Maggot and Flea Beetle use 30-35 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

Leafhopper, Flea Beetle, Colorado Potato Beetle, Green Stinkbug, Southern Armyworm, Potato Beetle use 30-35 pounds per acre. No time restrictions.

Downy Mildew, Meadow Spittlebug and Strawberry Rootworm use 30-35 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest. Applications during the fruiting period, do not apply less than 15 days or more than twice during the season.

Flea Beetle, Hornworm, Colorado Potato Beetle, Whitefly, Stinkbug, Tomato Fruitworm, Cabbage Rootworm and Tomato Russet Mite use 33 pounds per acre. Apply within 1 day of harvest.

Jack Bean Aphid, Bean Leaf Skeletonizer and Flea Beetle use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 40 days of harvest. Do not feed treated threshings to livestock. Sulphur tolerance varies with varieties of beans, check sulphur tolerance for your variety.

Cucumber Beetle use 33 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not feed treated threshings to livestock. Sulphur may injure certain varieties of beans, check sulphur tolerance for your variety. Do not apply prior to use.

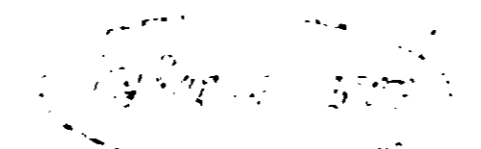

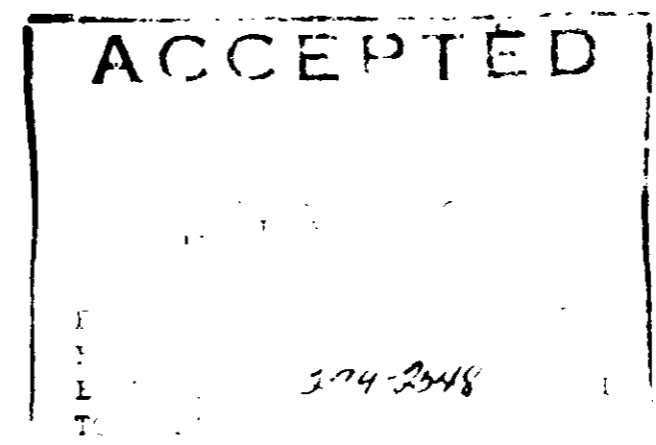
