Directions For Use

Apply when pests first appear and repeat as necessary to maintain control. May be applied with ground or airplane application equipment.

Blueberry Blueberry Maggot - Use 15 to 25 pounds per acre. Apply when first berries turn blue (usually in July). If heavy rain follows the dust application within 48 hours, repeat treatment immediately after the rain. Make two more applications at 10 to 14 day intervals. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower Aphids, Diamond-back Moth, Imported Cabbageworm - Use 25 to 40 pounds per acre. On Broccoli and Cauliflower, do not apply within 5 days of harvest. On Cabbage do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

Corn Corn Earworm - Use 40 to 50 pounds per acre. Corn may be picked immediately following last application. Do not feed forage to livestock within 10 days following last application.

Potatoes Aphids, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetles - Use 30 to 60 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 35 days of harvest.

Tomatoes Dipterous Fruit Flies, Near Fly, Drosophila, Aphid - Use 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.

Tobacco Flea Beetles, Aphids - Use 25 pounds per acre. Dig thoroughly. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

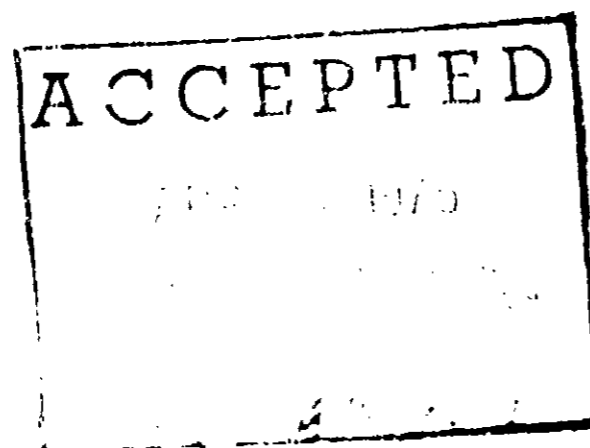
