DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply the listed amounts per acre when insects first appear and repeat as required to maintain effective control. Coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces is essential for good control. Observe use limitations. If insect control is required beyond the following use patterns, supplement the control program with other suitable pesticides. Observe days interval between last application and harvest indicated by number in () following crop.

BROCCOLI (7), CABBAGE (7), BRUSSELS SPROUTS (14), CAULIFLOWER (14): Cabbage Aphid, Cabbage Looper, Cross-striped Cabbage Worm, Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bugs, Stink Bugs, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Imported Cabbage Worm - 25 to 33 lbs.

COLLARDS (21): Cabbage Looper, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Harlequin Bug, Imported Cabbage Worm - 25 lbs. Do not exceed one application.

GRAPES (7): Grape Leafhopper, Grape Leaf Folder - 33 to 40 lbs. Do not apply to Concord variety as severe injury is likely to occur.

KALE (21): Cabbage Flea Beetle, Imported Cabbage Worm, Harlequin Bug, Cabbage Looper - 25 lbs. Do not exceed one application.

LETTUCE (14): Cabbage Looper, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Green Peach Aphid, Imported Cabbage Worm - 25 to 33 lbs. per acre. Do not exceed two applications on leaf lettuce. Do not exceed three applications on head lettuce after thinning. Remove outside leaves at harvest. Do not feed crop waste to livestock.

MUSTARD GREENS (21): Aphids, Imported Cabbage Worm - 25 lbs. Do not exceed one application.

SPINACH (21): Green Peach Aphid, Crown Mite, Imported Cabbage Worm - 25 lbs. Do not exceed one application.
