**First Aid**

If **swallowed**, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

If **on skin**, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water. Get medical attention.

**CALL A PHYSICIAN AT ONCE IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED Thimet (phorate) POISONING:** If symptoms or signs of poisoning (See Physician's Note) include blurred vision, abdominal cramps and tightness in the chest, don't wait for a doctor but give two atropine tablets (each 1/100 grains) at once. Remove patient immediately from the area where Thimet (phorate) is present. Remove contaminated clothing and wash the skin clean with plenty of soap and water to remove all traces of Thimet (phorate). Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

**Note To Physician:** Warning symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, nonreactive pin-point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps.

**Treatment:** Give atropine, preferably by injection, grains 1/100 three or more tablets at once and every hour as required until pupils dilate. Thirty or more tablets may be required during the first 24 hours. Never give morphine. Clear chest by postural drainage. Artificial respiration or oxygen administration may be necessary. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without warning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood tests.

#### Danger

**Cotton:** Rhizoctonia, early season Thrips, Aphids, Mites and Leafminers — Use 10 to 15 pounds per acre for a 40 inch row spacing (0.8 to 1.16 pounds per 1000 feet of row). On above disease control plus control of Mites, Thrips, Aphids, Black Cutworms, Leafhoppers, Whiteflies and Leafminers use 15 pounds per acre for a 40 inch row spacing (1.16 pounds per 1000 feet of row). Distribute the granules evenly in the furrow at planting time. Soil temperature and tillth should be favorable for good germination and emergence. Under adverse planting conditions plant stand may be affected. Do not allow the feeding or grazing of cotton foliage by livestock. Do not plant any root crop not registered for Terraclor® in rotation on Terraclor® treated soil.
