
#### WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

# AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product stray in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Stendard, 40 CFR part 170. This Stendard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural posticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE). #### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool dry place and avoid excess heat. Do not store at temperatures below 32°F (0°C). Rough handling may cause breakage, especially at low temperatures. Allow to warm about 50° (10°C) before use. Do not allow inner bags to become wet during storage. Do not handle inner bag with wet hands or wet gloves. Do not put concentrate or diute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills. Call FMC: (800) 331-3148.

To confine spill: If liquid, dike surrounding area or absorb with sand, cat litter, or commercial clay. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container, identify contents.

Pesticide Disposei

Container Disposal

When all water soluble bags are used, the outer package should be clean and may be disposed of in a sanitary tandfill, by inconeration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. If the outer container contacts formulated product in any way, it must be triple rinsed with clean water. Add rinsate to the apray tank and dispose of the outer package as described above.

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

The product in this outer package is a weltable powder formulation of the insecticide bitenthrin packaged in a translucent water soluble bag. Do not allow the inner bag to become wet before adding to spray or nurse tank. Do not handle the inner bag with wet hands or wet gloves. Pough handling may cause breakage. Do not store at temperatures below 32°F (0°C). Allow to warm above 50°F (10°C) before use. Cooler water temperatures increase the time needed for the inner bag to dissolve completely.

Talstar T&O WSB insecticide is to be diluted with water for spray application. Do not use strainers liner than 50 mesh size. Determine the number of water soluble bag(s) to make up necessary spray suspension.

Fill the spray tank ½ full with water. Open the outer wrapper of this product and immediately dump required contents into spray tank. Allow the water soluble bag(s) to dissolve completely. Start mechanical or hydraulic agitation, are a commended. Mix thoroughly to fully disperse and suspend the wettable powder. Fill the spray tank with the required amount of water. Maintain agitation during storage in nurse or supply tank and during application.

Mix as needed; do not store diluted material.
