DIRECTIONS

Container should be held at least 18 inches from foliage. Spray with a slow sweeping motion, covering approximately 1 sq. ft. per second. Upper and lower leaf surfaces should be treated. Avoid wetting foliage. Care should be taken when spraying young plants with tender foliage and new growth. For best results spray when the air is still. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90° F. Repeat as necessary.

Do not use on Ferns, Poinsettias, Hibiscus, Papayas, Pileas, Gardenias, and Orchids since plant injury may occur.
