DIRECTIONS

To release Bug-Blast, remove plastic protective cap. Press button, hold container upright and spray away from you. Do not invert can as propellant will escape. To destroy insects in a room, close doors and windows for maximum effectiveness. The mist kills so spray two to three feet away from objects. Open room after 15 minutes.

Crawling Insects

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, FLEAS, WATERBUGS: Spray into cracks and crevices and behind cabinets and kitchen equipment, dark recesses, floor coverings, floors and in animal and pet sleeping quarters. Spray 45 to 60 seconds for average size room. (9' x 12' x 10')

BEDBUGS: Direct mist into tufts and along seams of the bed. Spray bed springs and frame, also around baseboards, walls, floors and cracks. Repeat spraying as required.

ANTS: Spray directly onto ants and along ant trails.

Flying Insects

MOSQUITOES, FLIES, FLYING MOTHS, GNATS: Spray toward center of room in circular motion. For average room, spray about 6 seconds.

HORNETS, WASPS AND LARGE FLYING INSECTS: Spray 12 seconds in average room.

Outdoor Use

Spray close to ground and into insect hiding places to temporarily control flying insects (flies, mosquitoes and gnats). Do not spray directly onto plants. Spray 5 to 7 seconds per 100 square feet of lawn or shrubbery.

INGREDIENTS

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Petroleum distillate 20.50%, technical piperonyl butoxide 1.00% (consists of 0.80% [butylcarbityl] [6-propylpiperonyl] ether and 0.20% other related compounds); pyrethrins 0.40%; pine perfume 0.10%. **INERT INGREDIENTS:** 78.00%.

CAUTIONS

Do not puncture—prolonged exposure to sunlight or other source of heat may cause bursting. Do not throw into fire or incinerator. Bug-Blast will not stain if used as directed. 1. Avoid prolonged inhalation. 2. Do not spray directly on the skin. In case of contact, wash with soap and water. Animals and pets should be treated in the same manner. 3. Animals, pets, birds, fish should be removed from room or protected before spraying. 4. Avoid contamination of all food and utensils.
