



## DIRECTIONS (Always Use Full Strength)

To Treat the Yarn Floor Brush for First Time: Turn yarn floor brush upside down, spread the yarn over block so that the strands fall evenly on each side. Then pour on each 8" section, 4 oz. (½ cupfull) onto the yarn closest to the wooden block completely across both sides. Never pour it on the ends of the yarn. In this way, it will be able to penetrate each fibre of the yarn and still not be wet. For the first time only, allow three or four hours to penetrate into each fibre of the yarn. After first application can be always applied just before the yarn floor brush is put away after sweeping and shaking out.

Directions for Sweeping: The yarn floor brush should be spread out to full width and length, this is accomplished by simply raising the brush about two feet above the floor and then letting it fal to the floor so that it is spread out completely. Pushing the yarn brush across the floor will pick up the dirt and debris from the floor and at the same time will leave an imperceptible film of clean plastic which will give the protection

and the preservation that is so necessary to floors.

The varn floor brush should be pushed across the entire length of a floor, sweeping the debris ahead of the brush. The brush should not be brought up until this point is reached at which time the dirt will be deposited. In order to get the plasticized dust and debris from the yarn brush, simply take hold of it on the block and shake in quick short up and down motions. The debris can be swept up in one pile onto a dust pan. The corners can be easily cleaned by simply sliding the yarn brush along each face of the corner, thus the dirt is always pulled out of the corner and never shoved in. Retreat the yarn brush as often as necessary.

Directions for Retreating Yarn Floor Brush: If the dirt when shaken out is dusty or gray, the mop must be retreated. Use only 2 oz. for each 8" section and follow procedure as in first paragraph. Always allow sufficient time to penetrate into each fibre of yarn floor brush. Never apply more than what is necessary as yarn brush will become wet and smear the floor. It should be moist to touch, but never dripping wet.

Contains cleansing agents — therefore, when mop becomes too soiled, it may be

washed with warm water and allowed to dry before retreatment.

Daily Surface Care: Will control dust, protect against surface wear and help retain the lustrous beauty of your floors. As a dust cloth treatment or a dust mop treatment, it may be used in the daily economical care of many building surfaces and eliminates the need of many specialized cleaners, conditioners and polishes.

Removal of Rubber Marks: Rubber marks can be removed with a cloth or fine steel wool dampened with dressing. Continued use will make floors more resistant to traffic

wear and rubber marking.
