The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. As per Mike Mendelsohn's conversation with you, replace "POKOUT 35/ Aerosol Insecticide" with "DRI-KILL-E PLUS."
2. Remove the text below the net weight statement and the "Made in USA" statement.
3. Add "In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation." to the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section.
4. Replace "Remove or cover all food and feed during treatment." with "Remove all food, drinks and feed during treatment."
5. Replace "All food and feed processing surfaces ... rinsed with potable water before using." with "All food and feed contact surfaces and equipment must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse after treatment."
6. Delete the General Classification heading under the directions for use heading.
7. Replace the statement "May be harmful if swallowed." with "Harmful if swallowed."

## DRY MIST INSECT KILLER

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist and vapors. Provide adequate ventilation in area being treated. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. After handling, wash thoroughly with soap and water.

Do not get spray on drinks, foods, feeds, or surfaces that they may contact. Remove or cover all food and feed during treatment. All food and feed processing surfaces should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly cleaned with soap or detergent and then rinsed with potable water before using. Treat food and feed processing areas only when the facility is not in operation.

#### STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF IN EYES:** Immediately flush eyes with water. Remove any contact lenses, then hold eyelids open and flush eyes thoroughly with water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**IF SWALLOWED:** If conscious, rinse out mouth with water. Do NOT induce vomiting unless directed by medical personnel. Call a physician or Poison Central Center.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Contains under 20% Petroleum Distillates (possible lung aspiration hazard).

#### PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Do not use or store near heat sources, sparks, or open flame. Do not use in the vicinity of pilot lights. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F (54°C) may cause bursting.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

##### GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL:** Remove protective cap. Hold container upright. Do not aim or spray toward persons, pets, or vegetation. Before spraying, cover fish bowls, and remove pets and birds from the area.

**FOR FLYING INSECTS (Houseflies, Gnats, and Mosquitoes):** Close all doors and windows. Spray up into the air with a sweeping motion. No need to spray directly at flying insects — the mist in the air will kill them. Fill the room with mist, then leave the area. Wait at least 15 minutes before returning, then ventilate area thoroughly. Sweep up and dispose of fallen insects.

**FOR CRAWLING INSECTS (Centipedes, Earwigs, Grain Mites, Spiders, and Sowbugs, and Spiders):** Spray thoroughly on webs, and into hiding places (as under baseboards and floor boards; in most places, cracks, and crevices; in openings around sinks, drains, and pipes; under refrigerators; behind bookcases and cabinets; and in other storage areas, directly hitting as many bugs as possible. Repeat as needed.

**FOR ANTS:** Spray trails, nests, and points of entry around window and door frames, and openings around pipes and baseboards, hitting as many as possible. Repeat as necessary.

**FOR WASPS:** Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**GENERAL:** Do not contaminate other materials, including water, drinks, foods, or feeds, during transport, use, storage, or disposal. If damaged or leaking, soak up and wrap any waste, then dispose of as below.

**STORAGE:** Keep in a cool, dry, locked area inaccessible to children and away from flames, sparks, sunlight, or other sources of heat or ignition. Containers heated above 130°F (54°C) may burst.

**DISPOSAL:** Reattach protective cap on container, then securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
