Bug Devil FUMIGANT

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: 100

ETHYLENE DICHLORIDE, CARBON TETRACHLORIDE

For controlling the following grain infesting insects: Granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, rust red beetles, candelles, saw-toothed grain beetles, spider beetles, angoumois grain beetles, mediterranean flour moths, meal worms, cigarette beetles, drugstore beetles, cheese skippers and mites and grain mites. Also for fumigating in closed vaults to control clothes moths and carpet beetles.

DIRECTIONS FOR FUMIGATION USE: GRAIN IN BINS OR SILOS—Use in air-tight bin or silo. If necessary line with heavy paper before filling with grain. Level surface of grain, breaking up any lumps caused by mold. Pour BUG DEVIL directly and evenly on grain at rate of 6 gallons per 1,000 bushels of grain. If top of bin or silo has a large open space, cover treated grain with tarpaulin. Period of exposure should be at least 24 hours. If bin or silo cannot be made air tight, increased dosages will be required to insure effective fumigation.

GRAIN IN TERMINAL ELEVATORS — Drip or spray BUG DEVIL onto grain while grain is being turned, using 4 gallons per 1,000 bushels of grain or 5 gallons per 1,000 bushels of corn. Close and seal doors of elevator. Period of exposure should be at least 24 hours.

TO KILL MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES IN AND AROUND WEARING APPAREL AND HOUSEHOLD FURNISHINGS — Hang articles in air-tight vault at temperature of 70 F. or higher. Pour BUG DEVIL into shallow pan near ceiling, using 1 1/2 gallons BUG DEVIL per 1,000 cu. ft. of vault. Close door and seal. **Do not enter vault during fumigation.** After a minimum of 16 hours, open door and ventilate until no odor of BUG DEVIL remains.

WARNING! VOLATILE LIQUID — PROLONGED OR REPEATED BREATHING OF VAPOR HARMFUL. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Do not take internally. In case of spillage on skin, wash thoroughly. Read directions for use. Contains Chlorinated Hydrocarbons.

Note: Use of BUG DEVIL at temperatures lower than 70 F. is not recommended. Use in spaces not air-tight will require higher dosages and longer exposure. Consult local county agricultural agent for further details.
