DIRECTIONS

"Arasan" 75 is formulated for dry treatment of seed but is a wettable powder and, for special uses, may be applied as a suspension.

To treat Large Quantities of seed—use any suitable commercial dust treater or a homemade rotary drum; for Small Quantities—use can or jar. Fill drum or small container not more than half full of seed; add correct amount of "Arasan" 75; rotate slowly for 1 minute.

Seeds may be treated at any time after being well cured. Treat peanuts promptly after shelling. For rates, follow table.

Gladiolus Bulbs—Treat any time after drying. Coat bulbs well with "Arasan" 75 by shaking in paper bag or similar device, or by dipping in a suspension made by mixing 1 lb. of "Arasan" 75 in 8 gals. of water. Agitate the suspension frequently. If bulbs are to be stored, spread out to dry.

Sweet Potatoes—For the control of stem rot and scurf of sweet potatoes, dip the roots of the sprouts for about one-half minute in a suspension made by mixing 1 lb. of "Arasan" 75 in 7½ gals, of water. Agitate the suspension frequently. Plant the sprouts promptly after treatment.


