DIRECTIONS

Most green plants, including fine lawn and special golf greens grasses, are susceptible to disease, common diseases are: **LEAFSPOT, DOLLAR SPOT, FADING OUT, DAMPING OFF, BROWN PATCH, PINK PATCH, COPPER SPOT PYTHIUM BLIGHT** and **MELTING OUT**. In the northern regions grasses affected are: **COLONIAL** and **CREeping BENT, KENTUCKY** and **MERION BLUE, FESCUES** and **ZOYSIA**.

FUNGI-NOT will control and prevent **PYTHIUM BLIGHT, DOLLAR SPOT, COPPER SPOT, BROWN PATCH, FADING** and **MELTING OUT** diseases affecting Blue Grasses, Fescues, Bents and Zoysia Grasses.

WHEN TO APPLY: Begin treatments in early June and continue on a 7-14 day schedule, three or more treatments may be necessary and treatments should be continued until there is no further evidence of disease reoccurrence.

HOW TO APPLY: If using a watering can make sure it is "clean", and to 2 gals. water add 1/2 oz. FUNGI-NOT (1 tablespoonful). Stir well before applying to 250 sq. ft. of the affected grass area. For large area coverage with **PRESSURE SPRAYER, HOSE END** or other sprayer device, use 1 oz. (2 tablespoonfuls) FUNGI-NOT to 5 gals. water and cover 1000 sq. ft. 3 pints of FUNGI-NOT in 240 gals. water covers 1 acre. Use 4/5 imperial gals. for each U. S. gallon water specified.
