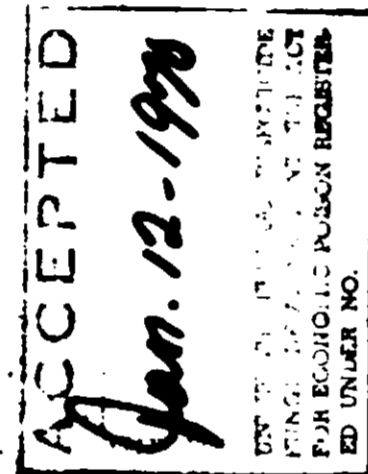

Side Panel: Directions  
Shake Well Before Using  
Permanently kills Poison Ivy and Poison Oak, roots and all.  
For spot treatment in non-crop areas, such as fence rows,  
vacant lots and waste areas. Contains added ingredients to ~~XXXX~~  
spread the spray and hold it fast to the shiny leaves. Ab-  
sorbed through the leaves NOTT'S POISON IVY KILLER is carried  
within the plant down into the roots, killing the entire  
plant. This action takes two weeks or longer but effects may  
be noticeable within 10 days. May be used at anytime of the  
year. Repeat if necessary.

How To Use: For close spraying hold button half way down and  
for distance spraying (up to 15') hold button all the way  
down. Spray in short bursts to the point of run off. Aim  
spray at top leaf clusters first, working the spray down to  
the base. For higher, aerial rootlets, spray from shoulder

level down to base. For Poison Ivy entwined in Privet or Lilac, cut vines at base, rather than risking spray injury to these plants.

Precautions: For prevention of ivy poisoning before or after contact with the plant, wash exposed skin areas with 5% solution of Ferrrous Chloride in 50/50 mixture of rubbing alcohol and water (available without prescription from most pharmacies). Never burn dead poison ivy plants as smoke can ~~cau~~ cause injury to skin and lungs.

Warning: Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Spray drift may kill adjacent plants. Avoid spraying on windy days or spraying too close to desirable plants. Do not use in greenhouses or store near seeds, fertilizers, fungicides, or insecticides. Store away from heat and do not use near open flames. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Keep out of reach of children. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes.
