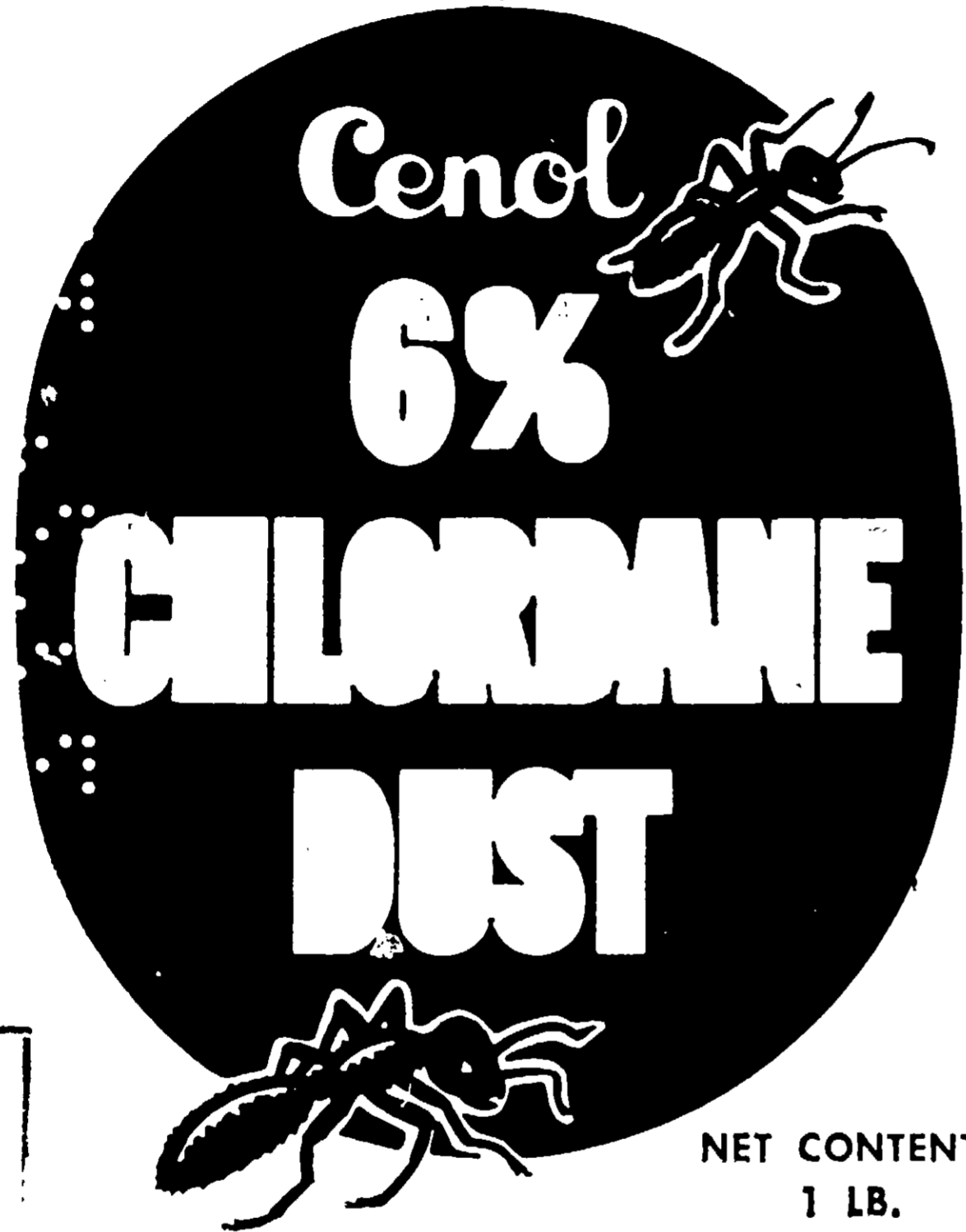

Directions for household use—For roaches, waterbugs, centipedes, silverfish, spiders. Dust thoroughly all cracks and crevices, baseboards and moulding. Rugs should be treated only on spots or areas where infestation is evident.

For ants, follow directions for roaches, also for treating the ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames. Repeat as often as necessary. Caution — Keep out of reach of children

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

FOLIAGE DUST—To control Thrips and plant bugs on flowers, rosebuds, shrubs and other ornamentals, dust directly on insect and plant. Repeat as necessary.

FOR LAWNS—To control ants, chiggers and chinch bugs, dust lightly using eight ounces per one to five hundred to 300 square feet. Repeat as necessary. For Japanese beetle grubs, white grubs and sod web worms apply 8 ounces to 125 to 150 sq. feet. Water thoroughly to force material into nests. Only one treatment a season is necessary.

FOR GARDEN SOIL—To control white grubs, cutworms, earwigs, mole crickets, wire worms, Japanese beetle grubs, root maggots on radishes, cabbage, onions, work into soil to a depth of 2 to 3 inches while preparing soil bed. Eight ounces (2 1/2 pounds) will treat 300 to 350 sq. feet. One treatment lasts for full season.

BULB TREATMENT—For Dahlia, Hyacinth, Tulip, Gladiolus and other flowering bulbs the following is suggested to control Thrips. Before placing in storage and before planting put a few bulbs in a strong paper bag with a tablespoon of Cenol 6% Chlordane Dust. Close bag and shake vigorously. Treat all bulbs.

HOUSEHOLD USE—Dust only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Any powder visible after application is completed should be carefully brushed into cracks and crevices or else removed.

ROACHES AND WATERBUGS—Thoroughly dust infested cracks and other hidden places and adjacent exposed surfaces where roaches will crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat application as necessary to maintain effective control.

SILVERFISH—Thoroughly dust baseboard areas behind shelving, bookcases and storage areas. Repeat application as necessary to maintain effective control.

SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES—Thoroughly dust infested baseboards, corners, pipes, storage localities and other infested areas in basements. Repeat application as necessary to maintain effective control.

ANTS—Thoroughly dust ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where pests may enter. Treat openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come into rooms from wall spaces and partitions. Repeat application as necessary to maintain effective control.

CAUTION—Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing dust. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Keep out of the reach of children.

Dust only in areas not accessible to children and pets. Keep children and pets out of treated areas until this material is washed into soil and grass is dry.

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

ANTIDOTE—EXTERNAL—In case of spillage on skin, wash promptly with soap and water.

INTERNAL—Emetic of 1 tablespoonful mustard in tumbler of water.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL—Do not reuse empty container. Containers should be disposed of by punching holes in them and burying or burning. Keep out of smoke.
