#### CAUTION

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED** — Call a physician immediately. Gastrolavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. **To Start Fogging** — Place fogger on table, chair or shelf. Pour several thicknesses of newspaper on top of paper to prevent blowing of surface. Hold nozzle about 3 ft. with top of the nozzle away from face and eyes. Push trigger firmly and pull trigger slowly. This starts fogging action. Sprays will stop after 10 seconds and cease blowing once. DO NOT RE-TRIGGER FOR TWO HOURS. Do not extend time and end use as follows. Do not use for 10 minutes after spraying.
