

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR THE SICK ROOM: All atensils, such as bedpans, urinals, etc., wash with a solution of three ounces of disinfectant to ½ galion of water.

For BOILING CLOTHING and LINEN used in sick room: Use in the proportion of three ounces of disinfectant to one gallon of water. Add the water to the disinfectant and mix well before using.

WATER CLOSETS and URINALS. Use 3 ounces of disinfectant to a gallon of water. Apply freely to all surfaces to be disinfected and scrub the exposed areas.

#### FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING

Remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of one part disinfectant to 100 parts of water. This mixture acts as a disinfectant against

#### S. typhosa

In the typhoid sick room, in the disinfecting of heds, clothes, utensils, typhoid steels, vrooms, and the hands of those attending typhoid patients, disinfectant should be used in the proportion of 4 ounces to each gallon of water.

Use one-half cup of the disinfectant to two gallons of water for mopping, scrubbing, sprinkling or cleaning purposes.

GARBAGE: To deodorize, sprinkle with solution, one-half cup to a gallon of water. Wash the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in can.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Red Mites: Paint or spray the perches, nest boxes, drop boards, floor and inside walls, poultry houses and coops with full strength dwinfectant, repeating as often as necessary Applied in this manner, it is harmless to the birds but should not be used directly on the fowl.

This disinfectant can be used anywhere where clean and sanitary quarters are desired. A partial list of places using this type of disinfectant follows: Hotels, schools, institutions, office buildings, factories, jails, public buildings, railroad terminals, theatres, stores, sanitariums and many others.

This disinfectant has certain advantages over contar and cresol disinfectants in that it is relatively non-irritating, non-corrosive and does not injure cloth, metals, etc., does not injure body tissues, is comparatively cheap in price, is not affected appreciably by organic matter and has a pleasant oder.

Every batch is tested for germicidal strength in a modern bacteriological laboratory - but before these tests are made the raw materials are checked in our chemical laboratories - and the finished product is then double checked.
