

FOLLOW DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY FOR BEST RESULTS

PITES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Infested areas should be closed tightly and filled with a mist of this insecticide. The space should be left open at least 10 minutes after treatment. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep and destroy dead insects. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

SPIDERS: Spray directly on spiders where ever they are seen. Direct the spray into infested areas such as baseboards, corners of rooms, around pipes and storage localities. Repeat when necessary.

ANTS: To control these insects, apply the solution to surface where they are crawling. Pay particular attention to door sills and window frames, repeating application as necessary.

CLOTHES MOTH: Clothing to be stored should be cleaned and aired, and sprayed thoroughly from a distance of one (1) to two (2) feet with special attention to seams and folds. Moth-tight chests and vaults should be sprayed thoroughly before being filled with materials being stored. If clothes are not stored in moth-tight containers, spray thoroughly every 30 days.
