1. For EPA Registration No. 432-626, delete the last sentence under ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS. It is not appropriate for a pressurized container.
2. For EPA Registration No. 432-455, delete petroleum distillate as an active ingredient; include its percentage with the inert total, and add a substatement to the ingredient statement "Contains petroleum distillates."

FLYING INSECTS: Houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats, smoky flies (treat around windows and doors and direct fog upward at a rate of 1/2 gallon per 1000 sq. ft. (92.9 sq. meters) of floor space. Disperse in all locations. Keep area closed for 30 minutes.

GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BEETLES, CHOCOLATE MOY BEETLES in exposed adult and larvae stages: Contact treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices, and secluded areas. For Carpet Beetles, treat infested areas along baseboards, and into cracks and under carpet where the insect is present. Apply 1/2 gallon per 1000 sq. ft. (92.9 sq. meters) of floor space. Repeat every 7-10 days until insects disappear.

COCKROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS: Hold a fogger nozzle close to the insect and spray directly into them contacting as many insects as possible. Apply behind baseboards, sinks, cabinets, coffee makers, etc. Repeat every 7-10 days until insects disappear.
