DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NELLITE 90 is a systemic nematocide developed for application to transplant water to aid in the early season control of root-knot nematodes parasitic on tobacco. Make the treatment when transplanting is completed for the field. Good control of root-knot nematodes is obtained by this water treatment. The rate of application is 1.0 lb. per acre of transplant water. The application should be made to the transplant water before it is used.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Keep product in its original container and store well. Keep out of reach of children and pets. Do not contaminate water by means of spillage or disposal of wastes. Dispose of empty container by burning or by the proper method for the disposal of pesticides.
