DIRECTIONS

FOR MICE, USE AN UNOPENED POUCH near burrows and runways. Protect from children, pets or livestock with boxes or cages where necessary. Use at 8 to 12 foot intervals.

FOR BEST RESULTS: Check bait daily. **FOR MICE,** bait continuously for not less than 15 days. Continue bait until all signs of feeding have stopped.

IMPORTANT: If bait becomes damp, mouldy or stale, replace with fresh pouch immediately.

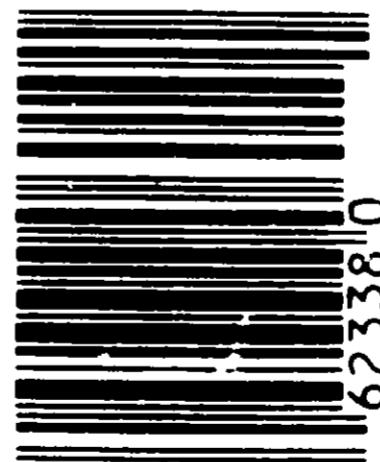
CAUTION: Protect children, pets, wildlife and domestic animals from the bait. If swallowed by humans, domestic animals or pets, call a physician, veterinarian immediately. The product may reduce the clotting ability of blood and cause internal bleeding. Antidote—Vitamin K.

Bait should be placed in areas not accessible to children, pets, wildlife and domestic animals or in tamper-proof bait boxes. Do not allow treated bait to be exposed on bare ground. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Apply this product only as specified on label.

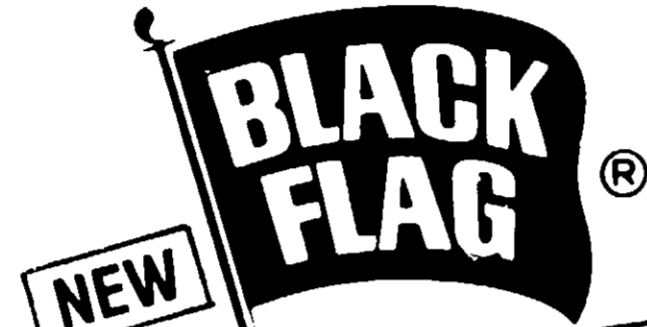
