Your Submission Dated February 7, 1992

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or 4(a) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. You have not responded to Item 4 of our letter dated October 7, 1986 to delete "resistant" from the phrase "resistant roaches" and the statement "Effective against chlorinated hydrocarbon and phosphate resistant roaches." These terms or statements must be deleted or substantiated by data demonstrating what specific chemical roaches are resistant to, that this product controls.
 - b. On the front panel under the list of ingredients please add the following footnote:

Contains petroleum distillates.

- c. Under "Precautionary Statements" change the second sentence to read as follows:

Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
