To Kill Flying Insects
Spray directly at flying insects for fast action. **Do not spray** (encircled) near children, pets, food, and dishes. Spray upward to ceiling. Wait 7 minutes for insects to die. Vacuum room for at least 15 minutes then let air circulate before re-entering.

To Kill Crawling Insects

Spray directly on insects where possible. Thoroughly spray in hiding places such as drains, cracks, around pipes, under refrigerator and baseboards. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool area away from children.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and place in trash. Do not incinerate.
