**MIXING DIRECTIONS**

To prepare a copper spray, mix the amount of Neutro Cop "53" recommended with 100 gals. of water and, unless otherwise stated, add 1 to 1 1/2 gals. of an oil type spreader in accordance with the dosages recommended by the manufacturer. Neutro Cop "53" is compatible with oils, and can be included with dormant oil sprays. The tank should be filled about 1/4 full and with agitator running add the amount of copper required. When the tank is 3/4 full, add the spreader and fill the tank. Keep agitator running during filling and spraying operations. Use on tree crops always requires thorough coverage applications to obtain good control.
