DOSAGE RATES ARE GIVEN IN TERMS OF TOXAPHENE 8-E. PER ACRE IN SUFFICIENT WATER TO PROVIDE THOROUGH COVERAGE (USU, LY 3 TO 10 GALLONS WATER/ACRE BY AIRCRAFT; 20 TO 100 GALLONS WATER/ CRE BY GROUND EQUIPMENT). EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE SHOWN, PEGIL APPLICATIONS AT THE FIRST SIGN OF INFESTATION AND REPEAT AS NEEDED ... MAINTAIN CONTROL BUT OBSERVE USE LIMITATIONS SPECIFIED FOR CERTAL CROPS.

MAXIMUM PERMISSIPLE RATE PER ACRE, EXPRESSED AS DXAPHENE 8-EC, IS GIVEN IN PARENTHESIS, (), AFTER EACH CRUP CLAIM

ALFALFA: ALFALFA LEAFHOPPER, ALFALFA WEBWORM, CLOYER LEAF WEEVIL, GRASSHOPPERS, CORN EARWORM, LYGUS, SWEET CLOYER WEEVIL, THRIPS, SPITTLEBUG, YELLOW-STRIPED ARMYWORMS — 2-1/4 PT, PEA APHID — 3 PT, ALFALFA LOOPER, ALFALFA WEEVIL (OVERWINTERING ADULTS), ARMYWORMS, CLIMBING CUTWORMS — 2 TO 3-1/2 PT, APPLY IN EARLY SPRING OR AFTER CUTTING BEFORE NEW GROWTH IS 4 INCHES TALL. DO NOT FEED TREATED FORAGE TO DAIRY ANIMALS OR ANIMALS BEING FINISHED FOR SLAUGHTER. (3-1/2 PT.)

ALFALFA (SEED CROP): ALFALFA LEAFHOPPER, ALFALFA WEBWORM, CLOVER LEAF WEEVIL, GRASSHOPPERS, CORN EARWORM, LYGUS, SWEET CLOVER WEEVIL, THRIPS, SPITTLEBUG, YELLOW-STRIPED ARMYWORMS — 2-1/4 pt. Alfalfa Caterpillar — 2-1/2 to 3 pt. pea aphid — 3 pt. Alfalfa Looper, Alfalfa Weevil (Overwintering Adults), Armyworms, Climbing Cuthorms — 2 to 3-1/2 pt. Apply 3 to 4 weeks after bud stage treatment. Do not feed straw AND threshings to Livestock. If Applied During Bloom, Do so only When bees and other pollinators are not visiting plants. (3-1/2 pt.)

BFINS: ARMYWORM, BEAN LEAF BEETLE, BLISTER BEETLE, CLIMBING CUTWORMS, FLABEETLE, GRASSHOPPERS, LYGUS (ON DRY SHELLE) VARIETIES ONLY), MEXICAN BEAN BEETLE, SERPENTINE LEAF MINER, WAX. EAN BEETLE -- 2 TO 4 PT. BEAN LYCAENID - - 2-1/2 TO 3-1/2 PT. CORN EARWORM - - 2 TO 3 PT. BEAN LEAF SKELETONIZER, DARKLING GROUND BEETLE, GARDEN WEBWORM, PEA WEEVIL -- 3 TO 4 PT. SALT-MARSH CATERPILLAR, SOUTHERN GREEN STINK BUG - - 4 PT. BEAN LEAFHOPPER, BEAN LEAF ROLLER. THRIPS-- 1-1/2 PT. NO LIMITATION ON USE OF SHELLED BEANS AS HUMAN FOC. DO NOT APPLY TO GREEN OR SNAP BEANS AFTER PODS BEGIN TO FORM. TO NOT FEED TREATED VINES TO DAIRY ANIMALS OR ANIMALS BEING FINISHED FOR SLAUGHTER. (6 PT.)

CARROTS: CUTWORMS (CLIMBING AND SURFACE FEEDIN), GRASSHOPPERS - - Z TO 3 PT. FLEA BEETLE - - 3 PT. APPLY AS A FILIAR TREATMENT ONLY. MAY BE APPLIED UP TO DAY OF HARVEST. DC NOT FEED FOLIAGE TO DAIRY ANIMALS OR ANIMALS BEING FINISHED FOR SLAUGHTER. (5 PT.)

CELERY: CABBAGE APHIDS, IMPORTED CABBAGEWORM, TALL ARMYWORM, GREEN PL JH APHID, SERPENTINE LEAF MINER, THRIPS - - 1-1/2 to 2 pt. VEGITABLE WEEVIL - - 4 to 5 pt. CUTWORMS (CLIMBING AND S REACE FEEDING) - - 2 to 5 pt. DO NOT APPLY AFTER PLANTS START TO DUNCH OR AFTER PLANTS ARE HALF MATURE. (5 pt.)

COLE CROPS (BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CABBAGE CAULIFLOWER): ARMY-WORMS, IMPORTED CABBAGEWORM, CABBAGE APHID, FAL ARMYWORMS, GREEN PEACH APHID, SERPENTINE LEAF MINER, THRIPS - - - - 1/2 to 2 pt. Cutworms CLIMDING AND SURFACE FEEDING) - - 2 to 3 pt. FL & BEETLE - - 3 pt. CABBAGE LOOPER, CORN EARWORM, DIAMOND-BACK MOTH, LARVAE - - 1-1/2 to 4 pt. DO NOT APPLY AFTER HEADS OR EDIBLE PARTS BEGIN O FORM. (CABBAGE 4 pt.) ALL OTHERS 8 pt.)

CORN: FALL ARMYWORMS, CORN EARWORM (FEEDING IN CORN BUD) - - 1-1/2 PT. FOR CORN EARWORM FEEDING IN CORN BUD DIRECT SPRAY FROM ABOVE AND EACH SIDE OF PLANT TO UPPER LEAVES TO THOROUGHLY WET AND RUN DOWN INTO THE BUD WHORL. CHINCH BUG, CORN BILLBUG, CUTWORMS (CLIMBING AND SURFACE FEEDING), FLEA BEETLE - - 2 PT. ARMYWORMS, BUDWORM - - 2-1/2 PT. CORN LANTERNFLY - - 3 TO 4 PT. LESSER CORNSTALK BORER 4 PT. DO NOT FEED TREATED FORAGE TO DAIRY ANIMALS OR ANIMALS BEING FINISHED FOR SLAUGHTER. NO LIMITATION ON USE OF GRAIN. (U PT.)

COTTON: THRIPS - - 3/4 TO 1-1/2 PT. FLEAHOPPEES - - 1 TO 3 PT. ARMYWORMS, BEET ARMYWORM, BOLL WEEVIL, BOLLWORM, COTTON LEAFWORM, CUTWORMS (CLIMBING AND SURFACE FEEDING), FALL ARMYWORMS, FLEA BEETLE, GARDEN WEBWORM, GRASSHOPPERS, LYGUS BUGS, RAPID AND TARNISHED PLANT BUGS, WESTERN YELLOW-STRIPED ARMYWORM, YELLOW-STRIPED ARMYWORM - - 2 TO 4 PT. DO NOT GRAZE DAIRY ANIMALS OR ANIMALS BEING FINISHED FOR SLAUGHTER IN FIELDS TREATED LATE IN THE SEASON. DO NOT FEED GIN WASTE TO LIVESTOCK. AFTER BOLLS OPEN, APPLICATIONS AT THE 4, PT. RATE SHOULD NOT BE MADE MORE FREQUENTLY THAN EVERY 5 DAYS.

EGGPLANT, PEPPER: ARMYWORMS, BLISTER BEETLES, CCLORADO POTATO BEETLE, FLEA BEETLE, LEAFHOPPERS, SERPENTINE LEAF MINER - - 2 TO 3 PT. CUTWORM, PEPPER WEEVIL -- 3 PT. DO NOT APPLY WITHIN 5 DAYS OF HARVEST. (3 PT.)

LETTUCE: ARMYWORMS, IMPORTED CABBAGEWORM, CLIMBING CUTWORMS, GRASSHOPPERS - - 2 PT. CABBAGE LOOPER, SALT-MARIH CATERPILLAR - - 3 TO 5 PT. DO NOT APPLY TO HEAD LETTUCE AFTER HEADS BEGIN TO FORM OR TO LEAF LETTUCE AFTER SEEDLING STAGE. DO NOT FEED REFUSE TO LIVESTOCK. (5 PT.)

ONLOWS: THRIPS - - 2 PT. USE ON FOLIAGE OF BULD CROPS EVERY 10 TO 14 DAYS: ON SEED CROPS WHEN SEED HEADS START TO APPEAR. REPEAT AT 7 LAY INTERVALS. DO NOT APPLY TO GREEN OR SPRING ONLOWS. (5 PT.)

TOMATOES: ARMYWORMS, BLISTER BEETLE, CABBAGE LCOPER, COLORADO POTATO BEETLE, CUTWORMS (CLIMBING AND SURFACE FEEDING), FLEA BEETLE, CRASS-HOPPERS, GREEN CHYRSANTHEMUM APHID, PINWORM, RUSTET MITES, SERPENTINE LEAF MINER, THRIPS, TOMATO HORNWORM, TOMATO FRUI WORM - - 2 TO 5 PT. DO NOT APPLY WITHIN 3 DAYS OF HARVEST, 13 PT.)

RINGE SPRAY EQUIPMENT AND CONTAINER. BURY LIQUID WASTE IN PIT IN NON-CROP LANDS LOCATED AWAY FROM WATER SUPPLIES.
