 - b. Rewrite the "If Swallowed" statement to read "Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting."
 - c. Add the statement "Get medical attention" to the end of the "IF On Skin" Statement.

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c. Rewrite the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

d. Rewrite the second sentence of the Disposal statement to read "Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."

e. Rewrite the third sentence of the Environmental Hazards statement to read "Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."

3. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Kills: Broadleafed weeds such as Annual Morning-glory, Beggarweed, Bindweed, Black Medic, Chickweed, Chicory, Clovers, Common Lespedeza, Curly Dock, Dandelion, Dayflower, False Dandelion, Florida Pusley, Ground Ivy, Hawkweed, Knawel, Knotweed, Lespedeza, Marestail, Matchweed, Oxalis, Piert, Pennywort, Plantain, Poison Ivy, Poison Oak, Purple Cudweed, Purslane, Red Sorrel, Redstemmed Filaree, Scarlet Pimpernel, Southern Brass-buttons, Spurge, Thistles, Wild Carrot, Wild Onion, Wild Violets, Yarrow, and Yellow Rocket.

TC 73 Weed Killer is formulated for "spot" application to individual weeds. This spot weeder produces a "foamy" white lather for direct weed contact which avoids drift and marks weeds as treated.

DIRECTIONS

1. Shake can just before using and occasionally during use.
2. Hold can in an upright position as much as possible.
3. Treat weed from a distance of 1 to 2 feet.
4. Push button down briefly. Spray to cover center of weed. Do not spray.
5. One application kills most weeds listed. If weeds do not appear to be damaged three days after treatment, repeat application.

NOTE: Avoid spraying or spattering of nearby flowers and other non-weed plants. Do not use on Clover or Dichondra lawns. Bentgrass, St. Augustine or Carpetgrass may be injured by use of this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
