



- This product does not control bed bugs.



Remove ALL animals, including pets and birds. Cover and turn off fish aquariums before initiating application. Turn off air flow systems in aquariums.

Cover waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and plastic dust covers in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspaper may be used).

Close outside doors and windows.





Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e. refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Fill out and place hang-tag on the door leading to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hr.

TO START FOGGING

Place a chair, table or stand in the center of the room to be fogged. Cover with several layers of newspaper, paper towels or plastic tarp.

Tilt can AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). Press tab down in locked position to initiate application. Set fogger on covered stand.





Vacate the treated house, individual apartment or other structure immediately. Do not reenter for 2 hr.

Wait 2 hr after application (until gerosols and vapors have dispersed), then thoroughly ventilate, either mechanically or with natural airflow by opening windows, vents and decre before reentering. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required.


