Subject: Amendment - Update Labeling
TAT Formula 18-5 Residual Roach , Ant and Flea Killer
EPA Registration No. 506-148
Your Application Dated November 3, 1988

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Add the statement "Recommended for Commercial Use" to the top of the front panel of the labeling. This statement is required since your product (although labeled "Ready-to-Use") requires transfer to a separate container for application. We discourage indoor use of pesticides by the lay person unless it is ready to be applied as marketed (as in a pump spray or aerosol formulation). This prevents the potential exposure to children and pets from ingesting and/or contacting the pesticide in containers such as coffee cans (for paint brush application) and Windex or other similar bottles which are commonly used by homeowners.

Allowing the homeowner to use containers other than the product container to apply the pesticide defeats the purpose of label instructions, precautions, and first aid treatment, since the information would not be readily available for use should exposure occur.

We discourage listing commercial sites and commercial application techniques on product labels available to the general public. This invites misuse of a pesticide by untrained individuals.

If your product supplies a spray head attachment and the product does not need to be transferred to another container, the statement is not needed.

2. Replace the sentences "Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared and processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed" with the following:

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment.

Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

3. Change the Note to Physician to read as follows:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Solvent may present aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally. Diazinon and Dichlorvos are organophosphate insecticides. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

4. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants" or submit an application to USDA requesting these areas. If granted you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.

5. Delete "for at least 15 minutes" from the If In Eyes statement.

6. Place the chemical name for Diazinon in square brackets "[...]."

Refer to the Diazinon Registration Standard, issued in December 1988, for any additional changes needed on the product label as required by the standard.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, EARWIGS, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SOWBUGS: Spray directly on insects whenever they appear. Spray into cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide and infest. Also spray, until wet, surface behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray ant trails, door sills and other places where ants may enter. Make these applications as "spot" treatments in localized areas.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application in areas of the floor and baseboard. Spray directly in cracks and under carpets where insects may be found.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray localized areas where pets generally live. Do not spray directly on pets. Replace bedding before allowing reuse by animals.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FLYING MOTHS, WASPS: Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat other places where these insects congregate and alight. Apply to localized areas as spot treatment only.

FLEAS, CHIGGERS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CLOVER MITES—OUTDOORS: Treat localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas where there is no food or food crops, spray infested areas.

The product is intended for household use.

DO NOT USE IN GARAGES OR PORCHES UNLESS THE AREA IS COMPLETELY ENCLOSED. DO NOT USE IN SPACES WITH VENTILATION.
