Recommendations for Use:

APRICOT: Use 50 lbs. per acre to control
Fruit Decay (Brown Rot Monilinia and Rhizopus Rot).

1. Apply 10 days and 1 day prior to harvest. Do
not apply within 1 day of harvest.

LETUCE: (head) Use 30 lbs. per acre to control Wilt (Botrytis
Rot and Sclerotinia). Apply first application at thinning.
Repeat application 7 days later. Do not apply within 14 days
of harvest.

PEACHES AND NECTARINES: Use 60 lbs. per acre to control
Blossom Blight Monilinia and Fruit Decay (Brown Rot Monilinia
and Rhizopus Rot). For Blossom Blight, apply at pink bud and
full bloom. For Fruit Decay, apply at 18 days, 10 days and 1 day
prior to harvest. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

SWEET CHERRY: Use 50 lbs. per acre to control Blossom Blight
Monilinia and Fruit Decay (Brown Rot Monilinia and Rhizopus
Rot). For Blossom Blight, apply at popcorn, bloom, full bloom
and petal fall. For Fruit Decay, apply 10 days and 1 day prior to
harvest. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

CANEFRUITES: (Blackberries, Boysenberries, Red Raspberries)
Use 50 lbs. per acre to control Fruit Decay (Botrytis Rot).
Begin applications at first appearance of symptoms. Repeat at
10 day intervals. Use a maximum of 4 applications. Do not
apply within 7 days of harvest.

ONION AND GARLIC: Use 250-400 lbs. per acre to control White
Rot (Sclerotinia). Direct seeding -- incorporate Botran in
top 1 1/2 inches of soil 1-2 weeks before onions are seeded.
Planting sets or buds -- dust Botran onto furrow when planting
so treated soil surrounds sets or buds. Rate per acre will
vary in local areas. Check local agricultural authorities for
more exact recommendation.


ROSE AND HYDRANGEA: Use 30 lbs. per acre to control Blight
(Botrytis). Field -- Apply Botran prior to shipment or storage.
Stored -- Thoroughly dust storage area and all canes and dead
foliage; repeat application during long storage periods.

GLADIOLUS: Use 250 lbs. per acre to control Dry Rot (Sclero-
tinia). Dust into furrow at planting time, so treated soil surrounds
corms. Use 30 lbs. per acre to control Blight (Botrytis). Dust
thoroughly. Force fungicide between spikes. Apply to blunched
cut flower spikes after harvest and before shipment or storage.
