DIRECTIONS

POTATOES: For early and late blight.

Start application at 20 lbs. per acre when plants are 4 to 6 inches high. Increase dosage with each successive application until 33 lbs. per acre is being applied to fully grown plants. Apply every 5 to 10 days as required for control.

SUGAR BEETS: For Cercospora leaf spot.

Apply at the rate of 25 lbs. per acre. Begin application before disease affects plant growth. Apply every 7 to 10 days as required for control. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest. Do not feed treated tops to livestock.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed thru skin. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact with eyes or skin, flush with plenty of water; for eyes get medical attention. Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Wear clean clothing. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not allow to drift into areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals.
