

For control of Brown Patch (Rhizoctonia Solani) attacking St. Augustine, Bermuda and similar warm season grasses, apply 2 tablespoons per gallon of water to 30 square feet (5 feet x 6 feet) or 1 pint in 15 to 20 gallons water to cover 500 square feet (20 feet x 25 feet). For easy application, use hose end type sprayer designed to deliver 15 to 20 gallons dilute spray while emptying quart jar. Pour 1 pint concentrated liquid into jar and fill to top with ater and apply to 500 square feet. Apply in spring or fall at first sign of disease and repeat in 3 to 4 weeks if necessary. Sprinkle after application to wash spray into soil surface. Follow recommended rate. Excess may cause a temporary yellowing.
