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## STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Get Medical Attention. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and water. Launder clothes before reusing. Final kill by root penetration may take from 2 to 3 weeks.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**HANDLING PRECAUTIONS:** When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical resistant gloves. After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower.

Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment until spray has dried.

If Container is OVER 1 GALLON UP TO 5 GALLON: Persons engaged in open pouring of this product must also wear coveralls or a chemical-resistant apron.

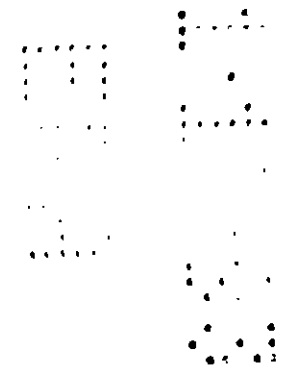
