MUSHROOM . . . To control <u>brown spot</u> or <u>dry bubble</u> (<u>Verticillium</u>), <u>greenmold</u> (<u>Trichoderma</u>), <u>mildew</u>, <u>soft rot</u>, <u>cobweb</u> (<u>Dactylium</u>):

Apply dust at the rate of 1/2 to 1 lb. per 4,000 sq. ft. Begin dusting soon after casing soil is applied and repeat at 3-7 days until small buttons begin to form. After buttons begin to form, apply dust only to casing soil between "breaks". Do not dust buttons.
